1. (4 mins) Welcome everyone, sign attendance, motion to accept minutes from^{November 20th} 2018 meeting.

2. (20 mins) PAC Business.

a. Winter concert: The Sign-up Genius was a huge success in getting the volunteers for this event. We had a really successful bake sale and 50/50 draw.

Tom suggested that maybe next year we set up a raffle for prime seating prior to the concert that way families know who the winners are before the event. Maybe 4 seats per family for the first row seating.

We asked Allie how the children liked having Santa come to the school and hand out oranges to the students and he said it was a success.

b. Movie Night: Movie night is coming up on January 18. The movie Small Foot will be playing at 7pm.

Co-op is sponsoring the popcorn for the event.

Connie has contacted Graham from RBC to have some volunteers for that night which includes a grant of \$1000 to have them attend.

We have requested that a friendly reminder of the rules be announced prior to the movie and Allie has assured us that Connie will say a little something.

Chris suggested maybe we can sell lollipops and we all agreed that this was a good idea

c. Lunch Program: Pizza hot lunch will be on Tuesday January 22 and an option of Pita Pit was also added to this lunch date. PAC has agreed that we will not double up lunches again for the same day

because it's harder for parents to decide which their child would prefer. We did agree to have special bonus lunches every couple months. We would still have our regular pizza and then a different week a bonus lunch added.

d. Dance: PAC and admin are still in talks about dates.

e. Staff Appreciation: November staff appreciation went over really well and no further dates have been established as of yet however we did mention another date in possibly February.

f. Fundraising: A school and community Walk-a-thon is in the early stages of planning. Dates have been established for Thursday May 23rd with a rain day being Thursday May 30th. 3. Playground Committee Report: Shannon has applied for two grants. (Community grant and Canadian Tire).

Our separate PAC account used for Playground purchases currently has \$11, 244.13. We also have another account for school based funds sitting with \$1,225.42 which includes the grant that RBC has given us.
