1. (4 min)- Welcome everyone, sign attendance, motion to accept minutes from March 19th meeting.

*Chris accepted March 19th 2019 meeting minutes.

2. (20 mins) PAC Business:

a. Lunch Program: 81 orders for the Subway lunch came in and it went really well. Joanne will just be asked to not take money out from the float fund. She can email Pat and he will make sure money will be transferred to her so she has enough funds. Dominoes hot lunch is coming up and all orders need to be in by April 18th.

b. Dance: Allie and Chris have planned a gr 7/8 dance for Thursday April 25th from 7-9pm. The cost of the event is \$5 and all proceeds go towards the grade 8 farewell. Canteen will be available for the students to purchase snacks at the event and PAC will provide all snack items needed to sell.

c. Fundraising: Walk in the Park pledge forms have been returned and tallied and students raised just under \$4000 for the fundraiser (\$8000 with sponsors). Sponsors names are already listed on the PAC board as well as the Walk in the park website. Gr 7/8 students will be designing cards for each Sponsor as a token of our appreciation and once done will be delivered to the donating businesses.

- ⑩ Shirts have been ordered, but only the students who participated in raising funds will be given one. Wristbands were ordered for all students to wear during the event (which cost \$159.80). Kahunaverse is the company chosen to make the shirts. Half the total bill has been paid (\$1328 with the remaining balance to be paid in full at pick up)
- ⑩ Giant Tiger is graciously donating \$500 worth of hot dogs, buns, chips and drinks for our BBQ afterwards. They have offered to help cook the hot dogs and send along the GT Mascot.
- ⑩ Canadian Tire is a silver sponsor who graciously donated a BBQ to raffle off at the event. Parents will be able to purchase silent auction tickets to win either the BBQ or Jets tickets which have both been donated.
- ⑩ Walk in the Park event starts at 215pm and takes approximately 30 min to walk. Allie will make sure to have the gr 7/8 students patrolling all crosswalks and roadways. The hot dog BBQ will be available from 315-530pm or when all hot dogs have ran out. A flyer will be sent home to all students with a permission slip and indicator of how many people would like to attend the BBQ.
- ⑩ Carter (kindergarten) will be receiving a \$100 gift certificate for the highest amount of money raised for the fundraiser.
- ⑩ Mrs Hill class won a party for the class with the highest percentage of participation for the event with 57%, followed with Ms Wakeman 55% and in 3rd was Mrs Viehweg class at 48%
- ⑩ Michelle Patton has interest in doing hair braiding for a donation to PAC at the walk.
- ⑩ Gr 7/8 students will go handout our Walk in the Park flyers along Westmount. Tom and Michele will handout the rest of them.
